<b>Week 1:</b> 16 <sup>th</sup> – 22 <sup>nd</sup> May <i>What is Fasting?</i>	Explore our Ramadan book box and find out what fasting is and means! Decorating shukran envelopes and adding money to give to poor.	Preparing suhoor snacks for pilgrims at the Haram.	Talk about orphans and think about how it would feel to be one. Write a letter.	Write out Eid cards for friends and family. Decorate the cards at the end.	Finish writing out Eid cards, design, decorate etc.	Read through the stories related to giving.  Find an activity in Ramadan box
<b>Week 4:</b> 6 <sup>th</sup> – 12 <sup>th</sup> June <i>Power of Dua &amp; Laylatul Qadr</i>	Read over books related to dua. Start making your own dua booklet – recap over the ones we know!	Laylatul Qadr. Explain what it is and make a Laytul Qadr night sky craft.	Teach and practise the forgiveness dua – make dua hands craft.	Practise making dua with mama and learning about the duas that Allah likes and ones we can make for Prophet (pbuh)	Explain the best times to make dua – a special hour on Friday, travelling, Laylatul Qadr – make a reminder poster!	Get packed and ready to leave for England! Explain why we won't be fasting tomorrow.	Arrive in England!
